Lake of Egypt, Pyramid Acres – October 17th and 18th

Lake of Egypt is off limits from Sunday, October 11th at midnight till the morning of Thursday, October 15th at safe light, and off limits again from Friday, October 16th at noon until the start of official competition on Saturday, October 17th. Any competitors in violation of these off limits periods will be disqualified.

<p>Official Practice Days and Hours</p>	<p><i>Thursday, October 15th and safe light til noon on Friday, October 16th</i> **During official practice days all tournament rules apply**</p>
<p>Mandatory Tournament Check-in</p>	<p>Each entire team must check-in at the Knights of Columbus, 1601 W. White Street in Marion, IL (618) 997-6210. Entire Team must be present in order to check-in for tournament, no exceptions. Check-ins will begin at 2:30 PM and will end promptly at 4:00 PM.</p>
<p>Pre-tournament Meeting</p>	<p>Pre-tournament meeting will also be held at the Knights of Columbus, immediately following check-in at approximately 4:00 PM. Pairings will be determined, and all team members (competitors and alternates) are expected to attend.</p>
<p>Roster Changes</p>	<p>Any roster changes presented after September 1st will be assessed a \$25 fee per change.</p>

<p>Daily Limits</p>	<p>** Boater – Only 5 Total fish may be weighed as follows: Up to 2 fish that measure at least 16 inches (“Overs”). Up to 4 fish that measure at least 12 inches but less than 14 inches. (“Unders”) A Boater’s 5 fish limit may consist of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 Unders and 1 Over; or • 3 Unders and 2 Overs <p>** Co-Angler – Only 3 total fish may be weighed as follows: Up to 2 fish that measure at least 16 inches (“Overs”). Up to 3 fish that measure at least 12 inches but less than 14 inches (“Unders”). A Co-Angler’s 3 fish limit may consist of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 Unders; or • 2 Unders and 1 Over; or • 1 Under and 2 Overs <p>All fish will be measured by swiping the fanned tail, there will be no pinching of tails during measurements. There will be no courtesy bumps at weigh-in. Competitors may request a comparison of their own measuring board to the official tournament board prior to weigh-in.</p>
<p>Flights and Return Times</p>	<p><i>There will be 3 Flights each day. Take off for Flight 1 will begin each day at safe light. Return Times will be as follows:</i></p> <p>Flight 1: 7:00 AM Take off; 3:00 PM Return Flight 2: 7:15 AM Take off; 3:15 PM Return Flight 3: 7:30 AM Take off; 3:30 PM Return</p>
